藉著今天的三篇經文的啓示,我們可以做出以下三點反省:

(一) 我們該經常祈禱,與天主建立持久穩固的關係

我們生活在一個講求快速效率的時代,我們吃快餐,身邊時時帶著手機,越來越多人乘坐飛機,火車不斷地在提速,這些發展都在幫助我們不要'浪費時間'。我們在做事或與人相處時,經常都會以講求時速來完成,越快完成越有效率。但是天主和我們的來往却不以效率的高低來衡量,儘管他願意我們儘早知道他深愛著我們。主耶穌來到我們當中,成爲我們中的一員。他本來有能力憑著一個行動或一句話來展示天主的愛幷使我們得到救恩,但是他幷沒有那樣做,反而選擇在這個世界上經歷了三十三年起起落落的人生。同樣地,天主有時願意以時間來教導我們如何去面對我們的生命。祈禱的重點不在于立即解决生活中的問題,而是和天主建立密切的關係,好讓我們能認識天主的旨意,按照他的聖意而生活。

(二) 我們該反省我們的信德生活

我們是否對那些有需要之人的呼叫聲裝聾作啞呢?或者我們是否對天主不再懷抱希望,認爲 他不會再俯聽我們的祈禱呢?我們應該學習那位寡婦持之以恒的態度,每天以祈禱來滋養我 們的信德生活。

(三) 信德生活包括維護弱小者的權益

寡婦在古代以色列社會中屬于沒有地位的社會邊緣人士。她們一般在生活中沒有任何保障,也經常淪爲有權勢者和富有者欺壓剝削的對象。身爲基督徒,我們的信德驅使我們去爲弱小者維護正義。天主時時在挑戰富裕的人,因爲他們有條件爲自己及他人創造更美好的生活。所以,任何在物質生活上比較富裕的人,都有責任去關懷和幫助窮苦的人。

教宗爲聖座新福傳委員會發表手諭: 不斷在各處宣講基督

(梵蒂岡電臺訊)教宗本篤十六世以手諭的 形式發表他的"不斷在各處"宣講基督的福 音牧函,爲新成立的聖座新福傳委員會的工 作揭開序幕,這個聖座新委員會的主席菲西 凱拉總主教昨天 10 月 12 日在聖座新聞室扼 要介紹了教宗的新手諭。

"教會有義務常常并在任何地方言講耶穌基 督的福音。"教宗的新手諭開門見山便指出 了教會的這一使命。"你們要去使萬民成爲 門徒",教會忠于基督的教導"爲使全世界 認識福音的美妙,從來不知疲倦。"教宗在 這份手諭中指出,對教會來說,福傳使命必 要且不可取代,是她本性的表達。這項使命 在歷史中根據地方、環境和歷史時刻的不同 總是具有彌久常新的形式,今天,它也受召 叫面對世世代代以來受福音熏陶的社會和文 化與信仰脫離的現象。教宗提到,近幾十年 來的社會轉變事實上"使今日世界的觀念起 了深深的變化,這一切對人生的宗教幅度不 是沒有影響。"要是說,一方面人類享有的 益處無可否認, 幷且教會也爲她所帶來希望 的理由得到新的激勵的話,另一方面却也看 到令人憂慮的對神聖意識的喪失。

鑒于自梵蒂岡第二屆大公會議起,保祿六世和若望保祿二世兩位教宗對宗教冷淡、世俗主義和無神主義尤其在所謂的第一世界的蔓延,已經表達了這些憂慮,教宗本篤十六世提出在當今世界傳福音的新倡議,他告訴我們這個世界需要"留意分辨",尊重"環境的差异"。事實上,新傳播福音幷非要爲所有境况運用同一模式,重要的是首先要"經歷與天主相遇的深刻經驗"。因此在新成立的聖座新福傳委員會的條例中便指出"要加深新福傳的神學和牧靈意義。"
