『我所目睹的,於是我作証!』

在今天三篇經文的光照下,我們做出了以下三點反省:

(一) 耶穌是天主的羔羊

羔羊是新出生的小羊,是無辜和純潔無瑕的象徵。從猶太早期的歷史中,羔羊就被用來作爲祭物,象徵猶太人和天主之間正確的關係。主耶穌來到我們當中扮演了這個羔羊的角色。罪惡造成人與天主的疏離。主耶穌的死亡與復活就是一個祭獻。通過主耶穌的死亡與復活,把人類帶回到天父的身邊,恢復了原有的親密關係。

(二) 我們應該學習若翰謙卑的榜樣

儘管若翰的宣講吸引了不少人來跟隨他,他很清楚自己的身份。他沒有因爲自己的成功而迷失方向,沒有忘記自己的身份和使命。他大方地指出主耶穌應當興盛,而他自己却該衰微。給衆人指出默西亞後,他就功成身退,幷沒有因此而感到落寞和無奈。我們無論做什麼事,都應該學習若翰的態度,認真地默默努力工作,不求任何功勞。成功也會成爲導致驕傲的一種誘惑。我們要無時無刻地反省自己的使命和工作,經常要謙卑地承認,自己并不是使命和工作的中心點。

(三) 主耶穌是我生命中的主

主耶穌在我們的生命中毫無價值,除非我們認真地把他置于所有的價值之上。儘管許多人說他是歷史的終點和人類的中心點,但是今天到底有多少人正在努力認真地活出這些觀點呢?很多人只是說一說或喊一喊這類口號罷了,很少人認真地以基督的價值觀來生活。在歷史長河中,許多人已經爲基督作證,認真地爲主而生活。問題的關鍵在于我們個人是否願意認真地看待我們與天主和彼此之間的關係。
