『你們要先尋求天主的國和義德,其他的一切自會賜給你們。』

在今天三篇經文的光照下,我們做出以下的三點反思:

(一) 我們的天主是忠信的天主

在今天的讀經一中,我們聽到以色列子民在痛苦中哭訴,認爲天主把他們給遺忘了。儘管他們所受的苦都是他們叛逆行爲的後果,但是天主仍是向他們保證他對他們的愛。我們在面對人生中的痛苦經驗時,有時會感覺到好像天主已經把我們給遺忘了。藉著今天的讀經,天主再次向我們保證,他沒有遺弃我們。他時時與我們在一起,藉著他聖子的話語,他聖子的聖體聖血,以及他的聖神,天主無時無刻陪伴著我們走在這艱辛的人生旅涂上。

(二) 我們的擔憂和焦慮顯示出我們缺乏對天主的信賴

主耶穌幷沒有反對我們做事情要謹慎,對將來要做出好的規劃,這是一種對生命負責任的態度。但是天主同時要求我們,將那些不在我們控制範圍內的事情交托給他。在福音章節中,主耶穌要求我們把天主和天主的國放在第一位,然後再把其他的事物按著優先次序排列下去。他也要求我們把錢財和世俗的東西排在它們該有的正確位置。如此一來,我們就會活出基督徒生命的優先順序,而不致淪爲錢財的奴隸。

(三) 天主是忠信的,我們彼此之間的關係也應當是忠信的

當我們信賴天主對我們的忠信,我們也應當在彼此的關係中保持忠信。就如一位妻子如何忠信地照顧她那患了十年痴呆症的丈夫,儘管她的丈夫已經不認得她了。忠信意味著不論將來的狀况是好是壞,我們仍然願意去活出那份當年所做出的承諾。忠信就是生活在世俗的社會中而不同流合污,幷以平和的心境面對人們的痞視和嘲笑。忠信就是結婚的夫婦、司鐸、修道人、獨身男女藉著投身服務人群而事奉天主。
