『誰吃這食糧，必要活到永遠。』

教宗在聖體聖血瞻禮彌撒講道中說：聖體是重建世界的道路

(梵蒂岡電台訊)「聖體使人與耶穌同化，跟隨基督的腳步，讓人能為他人奉獻自己。聖體是使人類大家庭合一的工具。」這是教宗本篤十六世於6月23日下午在羅馬拉特朗大殿舉行基督聖體聖血瞻禮彌撒講道時所說的話。彌撒結束後，教宗帶領聖體遊行，從聖若望拉特朗大殿出發，沿著梅路拉納大道一直走到聖母大殿，最後，舉行聖體降福儀式。

「在聖體內餅和酒這地上的果實轉化成基督的體血，為轉化我們的生命並如此開始世界的轉化。」基督聖體聖血瞻禮，教宗邀請信眾省思基督的奧蹟，他為拯救世界在十字架上犧牲自己並為每個人顯示了救贖之路。教宗說：「可以這樣說，在最後的晚餐，在基督受難的前夕，基督發自內心感謝並讚頌了天主，他以他愛的力量這樣做，改變了他前往面對的死亡的意義。」教宗本篤十六世接著說：「為了愛，基督接受所有的苦難，和它所帶來的痛苦和暴力，直到死於十字架上。基督接受它並以這種方式將它轉化成奉獻的行動。」

「這種轉化是世界最需要的，」教宗解釋：「因為它從內在拯救世界，並開啟了天國的幅度。但這世界的更新，天主願意總是藉著基督走過的相同的路來實現，這條道路，即是基督自己。」為此，天主賜與世界聖體，給了每個人得救的可能。教宗接著說：「天主願意藉由聖體聖事，這持續的轉化繼續更新人類、歷史和宇宙。藉由祝聖過的餅酒，基督真正的聖體與聖血，基督轉化我們，讓我們與祂同化，參與祂救贖的工程，藉由聖神的恩寵，使我們能夠活出與基督同樣的奉獻，像是結合於基督並在基督內的麥粒。如此在歷史的足跡中播下合一與和平的種子並使它日益成熟，合一與和平是我們根據天主的計劃所努力的目標。」

最後，教宗說：「當我們在聖體內與基督結合，我們同時也對他人開放。聖體讓我們成為他人當中的一員。使我們不再分裂，在祂內成為一體。」教宗接著解釋：「誰認出聖體內的耶穌，也會在那些饑渴受餓、赤身裸體、患病監禁，受苦的弟兄身上認出他；並且留意到每個人，對那些有需要的人給予具體的幫助。特別是在我們的時代，全球化使我們彼此越來越不可分，基督宗教能夠且必須讓這合一不建立在缺少天主之上，也就是不讓這合一缺少真正的愛。」
