#### "He [Devil] departed from him until an opportune time" (Lk.4:13)

"When the going gets tough, the tough gets going," goes an American saying. This American saying has a Christian and Lenten perspective. Yes, Jesus was tempted today, but he was victorious: how come? Two reasons: 1. Jesus was a man of prayer. 2. Jesus was a man of discipline - corporal and intellectual.

The only way to keep in contact with God, so as to receive the stamina to resist temptations, is prayer. Jesus prayed and he overcame temptations. Prayer is indispensable in the life of a Christian. Lenten period is the time to pray alone, but also as biological and church families.

Temptations come in concrete and physical desires: disciple is the only solution. Like Jesus, we need to be able to live beyond bodily desires. Fasting leads us to this mastery of bodily desires through discipline.

Can we fast and pray this Lent, so that we may be among the tough that get going when the going is tough? May we be victorious in our struggles with sin and temptations!
