Dear Parishioners,

"Jesus . . . Went up on the mountain to pray" (Lk. 9:28)

In our crave for a good life, we work hard to be able to pay the bills. For some of us, our schedules are crazy, hardly enough time to eat and sleep. Even for our kids, mid-term exams, homework, sports, and lots more. Sometimes we wish there are more than 24 hours in a day. Do we really need to be so busy?

What is true is that human beings need rests, from time to time. When we refuse our bodies sufficient rest, they breakdown in the form of stress, illness, fatigue. Indeed, our cars too breakdown for want of oil change, servicing, etc. So, rest is not only for human beings but also for creation as a whole.

Yes, we always plan our vacations way ahead of time, maybe because tickets are cheaper, and reservations needed. But where is God in all our working, homework, sporting and vacationing?

Jesus invites us today to the mountain of prayer - the Lenten vacation time. It is in the context of prayer that we experience transfiguration, because Jesus is with us. Prayer is the moment to shut out all our distractions, stress, and troubles, so to spend some quality time with God. Will you give God some portion of you time in prayer this Lent?

"All-day Confessions"

This Sunday's psalm proclaims "The Lord is my light and my salvation." In a few days, our whole Archdiocese will have opportunity to celebrate the revealing light of Christ in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. The light of Christ calls us to let go of all that hinders relationship with God and one another.

Remember that on March 6, the Sacrament of Penance (confession) will be available all day in every parish of the Archdiocese. In our parish, the schedule for this "all-day confessions" event is 9 A.M. to 9 P.M. There will also be an all-day Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at the Chapel. Please don't miss this chance. Prepare yourself in Lent for the coming of Easter.

Fr Ayo would also like to respond to the Archdiocese' naming March 6th the Day of the Sacrament of Penance (confession) for the Archdiocese of Edmonton.

On that day, priests throughout Edmonton would sit in the confessionals from 9am to 9pm for anyone who would celebrate the beautiful Sacrament of Reconciliation. At the Chinese Catholic Parish, Fr Ayo suggested Adoration from 9am to 9pm to spend some time keeping our Lord company when he really need us. We need your response by your sign up to be with our Lord between 9am to 9pm at the information desk.
