教宗傳教節文告呼籲信眾支持傳教工作

(綜合梵蒂岡電台·天新社·辛力社訊)教宗在本年傳教節文告中指出,傳教是教會的基本使命,所有信徒必須盡力支持傳教工作。教廷九月五日公布教宗爲本年傳教節(十月十八日)撰寫的文告,題爲「各國走在基督光照下」,文告簽署日期爲六月二十九日(聖伯多祿聖保祿宗徒節)。

教宗說,教會的使命是召喚各民族接受天主救恩,故此必須讓基督的光照耀所有民族。教宗說,散居各地的基督徒都要爲傳教而 努力,忍受痛苦,甚至奉獻生命。

「教會不祈求擴展勢力,不謀求統治,只願把基督帶給每個人,使整個世界得救。這項使命愈來愈迫 切,因爲人類固然在許多方面有重大而美好的成就,但似乎失卻了生命存在和終向的意義。」教宗說。

「教會的使命就是要鼓勵各民族懷抱希望。這工作不以人類現世物質和精神的需要爲目標……而是以超性生命的得救爲取捨標準,這樣的得救,只有在天國裡才能夠實現。」教宗在文告中指出

教宗說,天國的正義、和平、真正自由,以及尊重人性尊嚴的力量已在世間臨在,教會希望藉著宣講愛的福音去改變世界:「福音不斷照耀世界的黑暗,也賦予我們生活和行動的勇氣。」

教宗邀請全球天主教徒盡力支持傳教士,以及站在傳教最前線的團體,他們不少都遭到敵視和迫害。教宗亦呼籲每位信徒具體表現教會的共融精神,特別於全球經濟危機期間,在經濟上協助傳教士和傳教團體,使年輕的地方教會有能力以愛德的福音照耀當地人民。

事實上,教宗推薦給祈禱宗會的九月的福傳意向,正是爲傳教上遭困難的信徒祈禱:「願屢遭困難的寮國、柬埔寨及緬甸基督徒,能依賴聖神的力量宣揚福音,永不灰心」。

另一方面,教宗於八月三十日在岡道爾夫堡接見他教過的學生時說,喜樂能夠讓信徒成爲傳教士。教宗

誰最大、最好、最成功呢?我們總是在這問題上打轉!我們常常想設法往上爬,甚至爲了攀登頂峰,不惜把別人往下踹。我們或者。常常千方百計讓自己成爲鎂光燈的焦點,卻有意無意使別人黯淡無光。

聖史們筆觸所描繪的,是有血有肉的人物。不僅如此,他們還指引我們,怎樣才能脫離自我中心的舊習慣,怎樣才能克服愚蠢的「我最大、我最好」的舊心態。

那恰好是今天福音的背景。耶穌與祂的門徒們一起行走,遠離人群,因爲祂要親自釐清一些重要的事情。

他從頭起就講了一些令他們聽得莫名其妙的話。因為祂說自己將遭受可怕的痛苦,將被人用暴力殺害,還說自己不但不會就此死掉,反而會再復活。

耶穌要向門徒們講清楚的、祂自己身先士卒的,其結論是:誰最大,不在於誰自我表現得 最重要,或是誰一帆風順地高升;誰最大,取決於誰學會怎樣去服務。的確,這乍看起來 好像不可能。

耶穌爲我們指出一條遠離傲慢的道路;祂把一個小孩子放在我們中間,然後抱起他來,好像要對我們說:「忘了你們的惟我獨尊;學學孩子們,反璞歸真吧!你們應該彼此包容,就像我抱起這孩子一樣!也許,在我們行走的時候應該談談這些,而不是彼此爭論誰最大。」
