『主請增加我們的信德吧!』

#### 藉著今天的三篇經文的啓示,我們可以做出以下三點反省:

#### (一) 我們的信德能改善這個世界

就像第一批門徒,我們經常會認爲自己缺乏信德,沒有能力去幫助那些貧窮的、生病的、受傷的、誤入歧途的、落難的、以及那些需要知道耶穌就在他們身邊的人。我們不敢相信自己有能力給這世界或他人的生命帶來改善。但是馬丁路德·金牧師曾說:"每一個人都可能成爲偉人,因爲每一個人都能服務。"儘管我們的信德只有芥子那麽的小,我們仍可以藉著我們的愛心服務把耶穌基督帶給他人,讓人們體驗到最純真的愛。

#### (二) 我們需要改變自己的態度

身爲奴隸或僕人,生活的目的,就是服侍幷滿足主人的願望。在完成主人所吩咐的事情後,奴隸或僕人幷沒有權利要求得到主人的報答或獎賞。天主幷沒有欠我們任何東西;相反,他賜給我們的,要遠遠超出我們自己所能想像的。他創造了我們,幷賜給我們許多恩寵,幷且讓我們分享他的永生。這是基于愛,我們被召叫來回應天主的愛。如果我們願意讓天主自己作爲生命中的主人,我們就應該學習如何去付出自己,就如僕人一般,忠信地服侍天主。因爲服務就是我們這些被召叫的人理所當然該做的事。

#### (三) 我們不能賺取天主的恩寵和降福

憑我們自己的能力,我們無法完成天主對我們的要求。只有靠天主的恩寵,我們才可以活出基督徒的使命。天主的恩寵是白白地賜給我們的,它是來自天主的禮物。很多時候我們以爲,恩寵是由于我們的善行賺來的,這是一項錯誤的認知。只有藉著信德,我們才能和天主建立關係。在這份愛的關係中,天主白白地賜給我們恩寵,我們才能去活出基督的教導和要求。
