

親愛的教友們:

「....祂被提升天去了。」(路24:51)

我們也許都會爭議,天堂究竟是一個地方,抑或是一種境界。視乎我們身處地球那一個洲,天堂的方位應該是上面抑或下面, 我們也沒有定論。有一事情我們卻可以確定,天堂是我們的家鄉,這正是今日耶穌升天節最簡明的意義。

有了天堂作為我們的家鄉,意味著我們能明白,我們都是世途中的朝聖者,每一位朝聖者都清楚知道,終有一天,會返歸家 園。常言道:「月是故鄉明」。我們知道天堂的景況,跟我們現在身處的截然不同,所以天堂成為了一個我們眷戀的家,在那裏,沒 有悲哀,沒有死亡,沒有疾苦。

今天,我們或者需要自問,人如何能進天堂?耶穌死在十字架上,從死者中復活,光榮升天-基督承行天主旨意,因而獲賞榮 升天堂,最低限度,今日的讀經二是這樣說的,換言之,我們也要思索一下,我們存在世上,是否有甚麼因由:你我為何而生?

如果世人確知離開塵世之後,要面對天堂或地獄,那麼在我的生命和信仰中,就要有所表現。假如世人無懼死亡,冀望永生,那麼就要在我的生命中,有所表現。耶穌留給我們的任務,是宣揚對永生的盼望,亦即就是望德,隨著宣講福音、了解福音,不斷得到堅強。

本週的課題是:你我是否有向我們遇上的人,傳揚充滿希望的福音?假如我們未曾做到,這是因為我們對自己的救贖半信半疑,因此,我們未能將救贖的希望,帶給別人。我們是否可以讓自己對本身的救贖,堅信不移,作為一個開始? 艾朗日神父 C.S.Sp.

Dear Parishioners,

"... and he was carried up into Heaven" (Lk. 24:51)

We may argue about whether heaven is a place or a state. We may be uncertain whether heaven is above or below, depending on which continent we live in. What we are cocksure about is that heaven is our home - this is the simplest meaning of today's feast, the ascension of Christ into heaven.

The implication of having heaven as our home is the realization that we are pilgrims on earth. Every pilgrim is conscious that a day will come, when he/she will return home. As we often say, no place like home. But what makes heaven "home sweet home" is that our situation there will be different from what it is today: no more sorrows, no more dying, no more sickness.

Perhaps it is necessary to ask ourselves today how does one get to heaven? Well, Jesus died and rose from the dead before ascending into heaven - Christ merited heaven because he did God's will; at least, the second reading of today says that much. In other words, we too need to think of the reason for our existence here on earth: what do you and I live for?

If people must know that there is heaven or hell after earthly existence, it is my life and faith that will show it. If people will stop being afraid of death and hope for eternal life, it is my life that will show it. The assignment Jesus left for you and me is to preach the hope in eternal life, the hope that comes with the preaching and knowledge of the gospel.

The question for this week is this: do you and I preach the gospel of hope to all we meet? If we do not, it is because we are not sure of our own salvation that is why we cannot offer hope of salvation to others. Can we convince ourselves of our own salvation, to begin with? Ayodele Ayeni, C.S.Sp.
